A unique identification number, known as a Data-Universal-Numbering-System (D-U-N-S) number, is provided by credit reporting agency Dun & Bradstreet (D&B). This nine-digit identifier enables financial institutions to monitor your business's credit file. The DUNS system has been used for business credit reporting since the 1960s and assigns numbers randomly, without any relation to business type or other classifications. Lenders or vendors can use your DUNS number to access and evaluate your D&B rating, similar to a credit score for businesses. Having a D-U-N-S number offers several benefits, including being identifiable by corporations worldwide and having access to a standardized database system. It's essential to note that business credit is not protected by personal credit privacy laws, allowing anyone to access your business credit report after applying for a D-U-N-S number. If you've applied for credit from a vendor, lender, or creditor that reports to Dun & Bradstreet, chances are you already possess a DUN number. Note: The site will ask for primary reason of registering a DUNS number and contact info. Step 3: Proceed to checkout and expedite the process by paying a \$229 fee to receive your report within eight business days. Alternatively, you can wait for the standard 30-day period, which is free. Once complete, you'll receive your DUNS number via email after authentication.
